The following defines packages as listed on the registration form. Unless otherwise noted, prices include lectures, workshops, exposition show, all meal functions, social events, and CME. ***Fees listed are for registrations received no later than January 19, 2011. Registrations received after this date and on-site fees will increase by \$50 per category.***

Member refers to a physician who is a member in good standing with his/her home state association. Out-of-state physicians must send a photocopy of their 2010/2011 state association membership card or certificate of membership. AOA membership **does not** qualify. Association dues must be current to receive reduced fees. To automatically renew your membership please check the Renew Membership box as indicated, on the registration page.

Member Physician - \$495

This package includes lectures, workshops, exposition show, all meal functions, and social functions.

New Member Physician - \$395

This package refers to physicians who are in first or second year of practice and includes lectures, workshops, exposition show, all meal functions, and social functions.
